DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Remove water by forcing it over the trap with swab mop. Saturate swab with this product and wet all surfaces thoroughly. It is most important to swab under the rim of bowl or urinal to clean water outlets. Allow this product to remain for at least 10 minutes until all rust, scale, and stains are loosened. Rinse by flushing.

A to wet all surfaces thoroughly with swab mop, sponge, brush or cloth. Allow to remain for at least 10 minutes. Rinse with water after cleaning. Apply this product with swab mop, sponge, brush or cloth. Thoroughly wet all surfaces for a minimum contact time of 10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly with potable water.
