Net Contents: On Containers

A natural solvent distilled from citrus peels with detergents that has pleasant scent. A none petroleum solvent cleaner that will emulsify oils and grease so they may be hosed off. Made with pure citrus oils to protect the environment from the hazards of hydrocarbons and chlorinated solvents. This product will penetrate deep, removing the toughest grease and oils. Also great for use as an all natural asphalt release agent.

DIRECTIONS:

To declog drains and disposals, pour eight ounces of CITRUS CLEAN directly into opening. Let stand for one hour or more. Flush with hot water. To clean and degrease surfaces, add four ounces of CITRUS CLEAN to one gallon of warm water. Apply solution generously to surface to be cleaned. Let stand for five minutes. Rinse thoroughly. To remove flooring adhesives, apply CITRUS CLEAN full strength to floor and agitate with a stiff broom. When the adhesive has been sufficiently loosened use an oil absorbing material, such as those used in service stations, to pick up the remaining liquid.

CITRUS CLEAN is a concentrated organic formula that may be harmful to plastics or painted surfaces. Test surface in an inconspicuous area before using. CITRUS CLEAN is a powerful solvent and will defat skin. Rubber gloves are recommended to avoid chapped skin. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

Prevention:

Rinse skin with water/shower IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing Call a POISON CENTER or doctor/ physician if you feel unwell.

Precautionary Statements (First Aid):

Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, occasionally lifting the upper and lower eyelids. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Get medical attention immediately if irritation persists.

Skin: Immediately flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing any contaminated clothing and shoes. Discard contaminated clothing in a manner which limits further exposure, making sure to wash before reuse. Contact a physician immediately if irritation persists.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. If victim is conscious and alert, give 2-4 cups of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.

Inhalation: Remove from exposure and move to fresh air immediately and keep comfortable for breathing. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. If breathing has ceased apply artificial respiration using oxygen and a suitable mechanical device such as a bag and a mask. Get medical attention immediately if irritation persists.

Notes to Physician: Treat symptomatically and supportively. Consult a doctor and/or the nearest Poison Control Centre for all exposures.
