AP Foam Mate is a concentrated heavy duty foaming alkaline cleaner containing a proven combination of synthetic detergents, water softeners, alkaline builders, corrosion inhibitors, and water-soluble solvents. It produces a sable foam that clings to vertical and overhead surfaces to products excellent cleaning results. It can also be used to clean all surfaces-floors, walls, food counters, stoves, slicers, grinders, blenders, and conveyors.

Manual Cleaning: Mix 1 part concentrate with 32 parts water. Spray or brush on and agitate as necessary.

Foam Cleaning: Mix 1 part concentrate with 48-64 parts water and spray on as a thick foam. Agitate and rinse thoroughly with water.

Prevention:

Do not eat, drink, or smoke while using this product.

Avoid breathing fumes, mist and overspray as much as possible. Use only in well ventilated areas.

Eyes: Wear safety glasses when handling product. **Skin:** Wear appropriate gloves to prevent skin exposure.

Clothing: Wear appropriate protective clothing to prevent skin exposure.

Respirators: Follow the OSHA respirator regulations if exposure limits are exceeded or if irritation or other symptoms are experienced.

Precautionary Statements (First Aid):

Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, occasionally lifting the upper and lower eyelids. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Get medical attention immediately if irritation persists.

Skin: Immediately flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing any contaminated clothing and shoes. Discard contaminated clothing in a manner which limits further exposure, making sure to wash before reuse. Contact a physician immediately if irritation persists.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. If victim is conscious and alert, give 2-4 cups of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.

Inhalation: Remove from exposure and move to fresh air immediately and keep comfortable for breathing. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. If breathing has ceased apply artificial respiration using oxygen and a suitable mechanical device such as a bag and a mask. Get medical attention immediately if irritation persists.
