

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

**For Cleaning:** For cleaning food handling equipment and utensils, use 1 (one) ounce per gallon. Rinse thoroughly with potable water. Prepare a fresh solution for each use.

**For Disinfecting:** To disinfect hard inanimate surfaces (such as walls, floors, table tops) add 2 1/2 ounces per gallon of water. Apply solution with mop, cloth, sponge or mechanical spray as to wet all surfaces thoroughly. Allow to remain wet for 10 minutes and then let air dry.

For heavily soiled areas, a precleaning step is required and recommended. Prepare a fresh solution for each step. Do not mix with soap or anionic solutions. Product is noncorrosive in use dilutions on inanimate surfaces.
