Speak with your certified Algonquin representative to confirm proper dilution ratio and cleaning techniques for your program.

Before using, make sure that the desired surface is cool to prevent early evaporation. Read SDS and test in a small inconspicuous area. Dilute product 2-10 oz. per gallon. May require stronger dilutions depending on how dirty surfaces are to be cleaned.

If using a portable dilution center, connect to portable device, fill container, and then flush system if incompatible materials will be used. Make sure to use proper protective clothing when applying this or any chemical.
