This product is a heavy-duty, chlorinated, phosphate-free, alkali cleaner and degreaser, formulated with dispersants and chelating agents for fast cleaning and thorough rinsing. Designed for removal of fatty, proteinaceous and blood soils from food processing equipment, cold milk lines, cold milk tanks, etc.

DIRECTIONS

Equipment Cleaning: Dilute 2-4 ozs. of product per gallon of water. Clean-in-place, soak, or spray-clean the equipment. Rinse thoroughly with potable water.

Egg Washing: Use one ounce of this product per gallon of water. Pressure spray, soak, or use brush lightly to clean. Washed shell eggs must be spray rinsed with warm potable water containing an accepted sanitizer. CAUTION: EGGS THAT HAVE BEEN WASHED WITH THIS COMPOUND SHOULD BE IMMEDIATELY SUBJECTED TO A THOROUGH POTABLE WATER RINSE.

Do not store in sunlight. Never add to acids or any other chemical. Always make sure containers and application devices are approved for use with bleach products and contain theproper venting devices. If you are unsure, DO NOT USE IT.

NOTE: Before using any solution that contains bleach (Sodium Hypochlorite) make sure all applicators, tanks, and storage containers are approved for use with bleach and contain the appropriate venting devices. If you are unsure if any device being used is appropriate for use with bleach, DO NOT USE IT until you contacted the supplier of the machinery and containers. Missuse and incorrect storage is considered dangerous and detrimental to health and safety of the user.



Sodium Hydroxide, Sodium hypochlorite Danger! Harmful if swallowed. Causes severe skin burns and eye damage.

Prevention:

Do not eat, drink, or smoke while using this product.

Avoid breathing fumes, mist and overspray as much as possible. Use only in well ventilated areas. **Eyes:** Wear safety glasses when handling product. Skin: Wear appropriate gloves to prevent skin exposure.

Clothing: Wear appropriate protective clothing to prevent skin exposure. Respirators: Follow the OSHA respirator regulations if exposure limits are exceeded or if irritation or other symptoms are experienced.

Precautionary Statements (First Aid):

Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, occasionally lifting the upper and lower eyelids. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Get medical attention immediately if irritation persists.

Skin: Immediately flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing any contaminated clothing and shoes. Discard contaminated clothing in a manner which limits further exposure, making sure to wash before reuse. Contact a physician immediately if irritation persists.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. If victim is conscious and alert, give 2-4 cups of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.

Inhalation: Remove from exposure and move to fresh air immediately and keep comfortable for breathing. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. If breathing has ceased apply artificial respiration using oxygen and a suitable mechanical device such as a bag and a mask. Get medical attention immediately if irritation persists.

Notes to Physician: Treat symptomatically and supportively. Consult a doctor and/or the nearest Poison Control Centre for all exposures.
