What is Foam Brush?

A high foaming liquid neutral detergent for use in manual wash systems. This product contains special lubricating materials that will provide lubrication to any brush, helping eliminate scratching. The high foam is stable and very easy rinsing. As foam runs off, dirt is carried away with it.

Application Dilutions:

Touchless Presoak: 1:120-1:200 or 3/4-1 oz / Gallon Foam Brush Applicator: 1:120-1:200 or 3/4-1 oz / Gallon

Prevention:

Do not eat, drink, or smoke while using this product.

Avoid breathing fumes, mist and overspray as much as possible. Use only in well ventilated areas.

Eyes: Wear safety glasses when handling product. Skin: Wear appropriate gloves to prevent skin exposure.

Clothing: Wear appropriate protective clothing to prevent skin exposure.

Respirators: Follow the OSHA respirator regulations if exposure limits are exceeded or if irritation or other symptoms are experienced.

Precautionary Statements (First Aid):

Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, occasionally lifting the upper and lower eyelids. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do. Get medical attention immediately if irritation persists.

Skin: Immediately flush skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes while removing any contaminated clothing and shoes. Discard contaminated clothing in a manner which limits further exposure, making sure to wash before reuse. Contact a physician immediately if irritation persists.

Ingestion: Do not induce vomiting. If victim is conscious and alert, give 2-4 cups of water. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.

Inhalation: Remove from exposure and move to fresh air immediately and keep comfortable for breathing. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. If breathing has ceased apply artificial respiration using oxygen and a suitable mechanical device such as a bag and a mask. Get medical attention immediately if irritation persists.

Notes to Physician: Treat symptomatically and supportively. Consult a doctor and/or the nearest Poison Control Centre for all exposures.
